

STAP – Studies Abroad Programme



- One term abroad at one of our partner universities worldwide which means:
 - No tuition fees
 - Erasmus

Also:

- Credit transfer options (modules Studies Abroad, Studium Integrale)
- For bachelor students: Use your 4th or 5th semester for a term abroad
- For master students: use your 3rd or 4th semester for a term abroad

Main selection round in 2020: 1st December 2020 to 15th January 2021

Optional secondary selection round: spring, starting April 15, ending June 1 (limited options available) – not guaranteed

Study Abroad Programme (STAP)



Bachelor students

- Be enrolled as a student at the WiSo Faculty
- Currently: At least an average of 15 ECTS completed per semester
- English level of at least B2, verifiable by one of the English tests listed in the STAP Bachelor application manual: https://international.wiso.uni-koeln.de/en/outgoing-students/term-abroad/stap-bachelor

Master students

- Apply in your first master semester
- For participation in MBA school exchange: proof of working experience
- English level of at least B2, verifiable by one of the English tests listed in the STAP


